In the First Circle is based on Solzhenitsyn's own time in a prison research institute, the slang term for which is sharashka. It is located in a Moscow suburb named Marfino (slightly disguised as Mavrino in the eighty-seven-chapter version), specifically in a former seminary building that the Soviet authorities turned into a place of incarceration, a metamorphosis that has both historical and symbolic significance.
